Money Talks!

The JRMCC Sport, Culture & Recreation Department is a non-government funded program and therefore does not receive band funds through the FTA (Financial Transfer Agreement). Among the numerous Internal Council's (La Ronge, Hall Lake & Sucker River) priorities is sports and recreation. As such the department, as approved by Internal Council, is funded 100% by Casino Funds. The 2013-2014 annual budget was approved in the amount of \$1.1 million. Approximately \$190,000.00 must be fundraised by the department in order for JRMCC to meet the budget projections, this both a challenge and a huge responsibility. The budget covers such expenses like operations and maintenance, staff salaries and programming. The JRMCC Director is part of the Program Directors Working Group, which includes the Chief Financial Officer, along with La Ronge Internal Council, who meet monthly to review financial statements and ensure the budgets are on track.
